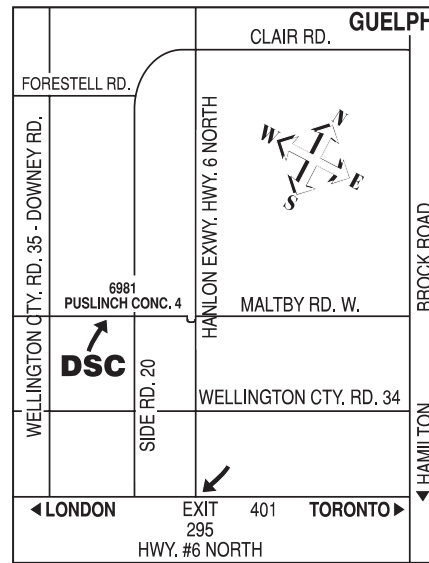

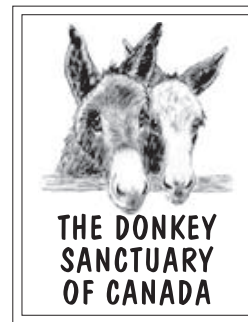

If you choose, you can spend a moment (or several) stroking a donkey's coat. There's also a good chance you'll meet a friendly sheep or two, and an equal chance you may receive a gentle, attention-seeking nudge from an inquisitive goat.

The Sanctuary is 100 acres of tranquility, in which we strive to live in peaceful harmony with the animals we have rescued. It is our heartfelt mission to ensure the animals who come to live out the remainder of their lives on our Farm are surrounded by love, dignity, and the respect they so richly deserve.

## Who does the DSC help?

The Donkey Sanctuary of Canada is a refuge for donkeys, mules and hinnies who have been neglected or abused, or who can no longer be cared for by their owners. The Donkey Sanctuary rescues the donkey with hooves so long it lives in constant pain and cannot walk. It saves a terrified



mule shivering in a pen in a slaughterhouse. It offers a home to a much-loved donkey whose aging owners can no longer provide adequate care. After years of suffering and neglect, the Sanctuary provides these animals with a welcome and often life-saving peaceful haven.

## Our mission.

The Donkey Sanctuary of Canada is a not-for-profit licensed charity. We provide a lifelong home to donkeys, mules and hinnies that are unwanted, neglected or abused. In addition, we provide the DSC Foster Farm Program, the DSC Humane Education Program and the DSC Life Skills Program.
