## A refuge since 1992

---

The Donkey Sanctuary of Canada is a refuge for donkeys, mules and hinnies who have been neglected or abused, or who can no longer be cared for by their owners.

The Donkey Sanctuary rescues the donkey with hooves so long it lives in constant pain and cannot walk. It aids the terrified mule shivering in a pen in a slaughterhouse. It offers a home to a much-loved donkey whose aging owners can no longer provide adequate care. The Sanctuary provides a welcome and often life-saving haven. Visitors are warmly welcomed.
